Jim Toman One-Day Prospect Camp (June 24)

Ages: High School Grades 9-12

Cost: \$150.00

Time: 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM

The camp is for high school-age players who will be in grades 9 through 12 whose goal is to play college baseball. Coaches and players will be giving instruction in all facets of the game, from positional play, pitching, and hitting.

The campers will be instructed by the entire Liberty University coaching staff and other college coaches from various levels. The camp will involve a pro-style workout in the morning where each participant will run the 60, field and throw from their position, and catchers will throw down to second and third. The afternoon will consist of rotations involving a full batting practice session on the field, hitting tee velocity, hitting tee work, hitting instruction in the indoor cages, defense on the field, and bullpen work with the pitchers.

Each camper can receive a complete analysis of his baseball skills upon request. Currently, Liberty has 15 players on its roster who have participated in past Liberty camps.

****There will be other college coaches on hand to help instruct and teach each player.****

****Camp will be held on Thursday to avoid missing anytime from tournament or showcase teams playing during the weekend.****

Liberty University Coaching Staff

Head Coach: Jim Toman

Coach Toman is beginning his third year as the Head Coach at Liberty University. The past 11 seasons he spent as the Associate Head Coach at the University of South Carolina. In his time there he had 11 top 25 recruiting classes including 3 classes that were #1 in the country. He has been to 14 NCAA regionals, 8 super-regionals, and 3 College World Series. In his first two seasons as head coach, he has won a record 68 games. The Flames set school records for fielding percentage (.974), HBP (95) and conference wins (17).

Assistant Coach: Jason Murray

Coach Murray is in his first year with the Liberty Flames after coming his second stint at Winthrop University. Coach Murray was the Head Coach at Charleston Southern for four years, recruiting coordinator at University of Michigan, and assistant at the University of Florida. Coach Murray will serve as the infield and hitting coach, as well as the recruiting coordinator. His experience and energy will be a tremendous asset.

Assistant Coach: Garrett Quinn

Coach Quinn is in his second year at Liberty after coming from Stetson University, and will serve as the pitching coach, handle the catchers, and assist in recruiting. Coach Quinn went to two regionals as an assistant at the University of Florida, and three regionals during his time as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Stetson. In 2007, Quinn's pitching staff was ranked 30th in the country in ERA. In 2009, the flames had an ERA of 5.27 as a staff, and had one pitcher drafted by the Atlanta Braves.

Assistant Coach: Adam Ward

Coach Ward enters his first year with Liberty University Baseball. Coach Ward just finished his collegiate playing career as a catcher at Clemson University. The past four years, Coach Ward has also worked with the North Charleston Dixie Youth Majors. In his four years with North Charleston, Coach Ward helped guide the team to two State Championship (2007, 2008), and two World Series Championships (2006, 2009). Coach Ward will be working with the outfielders, and assisting with the catchers and hitters.

Director of Operations: Billy Daniels

Coach Daniels is in his second year with the flames as the director of operations after being an assistant at Virginia Commonwealth University, and the pitching coach at Longwood University in 2008. Daniels assisted Longwood in recruiting and led the pitching staff to a #14 rank nationally in walks/nine innings along with being in the top 75 in the country in ERA.

Both days of camp will involve workouts under the lights at night for a great college baseball experience!

The first day of camp will involve a pro-style workout that night under the lights, where each participant will run the 60, field and throw from their position, and catchers will throw down to second and third. The second day will consist of a full day of instruction involving positional play, live batting practice on the field, hitting tee velocity, hitting tee work, hitting instruction in the indoor cages, bullpen and drill work for the pitchers, and instruction in arm care and core workouts.
