Cost

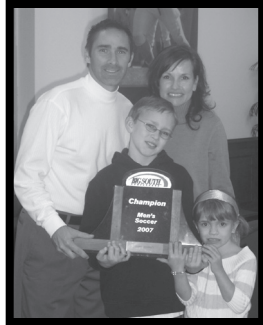
