The Game

Liberty (5-1, 0-0 Big South) returns home for the first time since Nov. 16 to host Virginia Tech (5-4, 0-0 ACC). The Lady Flames are seeking their first-ever win against the Hokies, who have won all 12 previous head-to-head match-ups. Liberty has won 21-straight contests at the Vines Center.

The Last Time Out

The Lady Flames suffered their first setback of the 2006-07 campaign, dropping a 74-64 decision at James Madison on Nov. 29. Meredith Alexis tallied 28 points and 11 rebounds to lead the Dukes to their 15th-consecutive victory at the JMU Convocation Center. Michelle Parker scored all 13 of her tallies after halftime to pace the visitors.

All Lady Flames basketball games can be heard LIVE on WWMC 90.9 FM "The Light." Jamie Hall, who is celebrating his 13th year of broadcasting Lady Flames basketball, will once again be handling the courtside play-by-play duties for all road games and selected home contests. Jerod Brooks and Nick Pierce will serve as the primary commentators for home games.

Liberty University Head Coach: Carey Green (Coastal Carolina, '79)

Record at Liberty: 171-53 (Eight years)

Overall Record: Same

Carey Green, the eighth-year head coach of the Lady Flames, is steadily earning the right to be considered one of the top college women's basketball coaches in America. Green has accumulated a 171-53 record in his seven-plus years on the Liberty bench, good for a winning percentage of .763. He ranked ninth among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches in that category, entering the season.

Liberty has won the Big South Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in each of Green's seven seasons as the Lady Flames' head coach. Liberty has totaled 23 or more victories in six of those years, including the 2004-05 season that saw the Lady Flames reach the Sweet 16 for the first time in the program's history.

Green has actually been to the postseason in each of his last 19 seasons as a women's basketball coach, a span which includes a dozen years as an assistant coach at Clemson. In all but one of those 19 appearances, he has experienced the NCAA Tournament.

The 2005-06 season represented one of the best coaching jobs of Green's career. The Lady Flames had lost the top four scorers from the Sweet 16 squad to graduation. Moreover, freshman Megan Frazee averaged 18.5 points and 9.8 rebounds per game through the first 14 games of her collegiate career, but was lost for the remainder of the season due to injury. Yet, Liberty was still able to win 25 games, its 10th-straight Big South title and its 10th-consecutive NCAA Tournament berth.

Green's efforts were recognized by both the Big South Conference and the Virginia Sports Information Directors Association (VaSID). Both groups named Green as their women's basketball coach of the year at season's end. It was the third time that he has won each of those honors and is the second-straight time Green was selected as the VaSID Coach of the Year.

A key late-season conference victory over High Point made Green the winningest coach in Big South Conference history. The previous season, Green had passed Rick Reeves as Liberty's career wins leader.

That was just one of the many reasons that the 2004-05 year was a special one on Liberty Mountain. A senior-laden Lady Flames team recorded upset wins over No. 4 seed Penn State (78-70) and No. 5 seed DePaul (88-79) in the first two rounds of the NCAA Tournament, becoming just the second team ever to advance to the Sweet 16 as a No. 13 seed. The Lady Flames ended the season with their highest national ranking to date, 21st (USA Today/ESPN).

Even with all his accolades, Green is not yet satisfied. The native of Louisville, Tenn., located just outside of Knoxville, knows there's work yet to be done with the Lady Flames.

"We have some tremendous challenges ahead of us and I believe the team will be up to those challenges," Green says. "I am pleased with the direction and progress of our program but of course, I, as well as the team, have higher aspirations, goals and expectations."

Green's track record shows that he has the ability to meet those challenges. The Lady Flames have recorded two wins over Virginia and West Virginia and victories over No. 19 DePaul, No. 17 Kansas State, No. 25 Penn State, Wake Forest and UNLV during Green's tenure. The upset victory over the 25th-ranked Cavaliers in 2003 marked Liberty's first win over a Top 25 team.

His record against conference foes is equally impressive, as he led the Lady Flames to a Big South record 46-game winning streak and currently has a .941 (112-7) winning percentage against conference teams. Green has marched through conference play with one or fewer setbacks five times in his seven years, while guiding the Lady Flames to two undefeated conference seasons.

Scouting Virginia Tech

Virginia Tech was 21-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament last season with a first-round win over Missouri. Four starters, including three 1,000-point scorers, were lost to graduation, leaving the Hokies in a bit of a rebuilding mode this season.

Coach Beth Dunkenberger's squad is 5-4 to start the 2006-07 season and has a win over West Virginia to its credit. Kirby Copeland, a 5-10 senior guard, is averaging a team-high 15.0 ppg to go along with 5.1 rpg and 5.2 apg. Nare Diawara, a 6-6 senior center, posts 11.4 ppg and 7.3 rpg.

The Coaching Matchup

Liberty Head Coach Carey Green is in his eighth season with the Lady Flames. He owns a 171-53 career record and is the all-time wins leader at Liberty and among Big South women's basketball coaches. His career winning percentage (.763) ranked ninth among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches at the season's outset.

Beth Dunkenberger is starting her third season at Virginia Tech and is 43-26 with the Hokies. Her overall record, which also includes four years at Western Carolina, is 108-76.

Series Record

Virginia Tech owns a 12-0 all-time record against the Lady Flames, including a 6-0 mark in Lynchburg. The Hokies defeated Liberty, 70-60, in the teams' most recent match-up, Dec. 10, 2005 at Cassell Coliseum. Kerri Gardin paced Virginia Tech with 20 points and 14 boards, helping the home team record a 42-22 edge in points in the paint. Megan Frazee totaled 20 points and 10 caroms for Liberty.

Liberty Versus Atlantic Coast Conference

Liberty is 3-27 against current members of the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including its 75-71 win at Virginia on Nov. 20. The Lady Flames are 0-1 versus Boston College, 0-3 versus Duke, 0-1 versus North Carolina, 0-1 versus N.C. State, 2-6 versus Virginia, 0-12 versus Virginia Tech and 1-3 versus Wake Forest. Liberty will play at the Dec. 29-30 Terrapin Classic and may meet Maryland for the first time at the event.

Big South Player of the Week x 2

Megan Frazee has been named the Big South Conference Choice Hotels Player of the Week twice so far this season. The sophomore, who has now captured this award four times in her career, garnered her most recent honor after helping the Lady Flames pick up victories at Virginia (Nov. 20) and Binghamton (Nov. 25). Frazee, who posted 37 points and 15 rebounds at Virginia, averaged a team-high 24.0 ppg and 10.5 rpg in the two contests.

Home Sweet Home

In recent years, the "Furnace" has been anything but warm to opponents. Liberty has dominated its opponents at home, going 75-7 (.915) at the Vines Center since the start of the 2000-01 season. Under Head Coach Carey Green, the Lady Flames are 86-10 (.896) at home.

Liberty went 15-0 at the Vines Center last season, marking the fourth time in school history that the Lady Flames have enjoyed a perfect home record. With its home triumphs over Norfolk State and Columbia Union, Liberty has now won 21-consecutive home tilts, dating back to the end of the 2004-05 campaign. The longest home winning streak in school history is 24 games, spanning the 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons.

Winningest Active Coaches

After the completion of his seventh season, Liberty Head Coach Carey Green remains in elite company. Green ranked as the ninth-winningest head coach among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches at the beginning of the 2006-07 season, with his .761 winning percentage.

Record in December

The Lady Flames have posted an all-time record of 68-91 in games played in the month of December. Last season, Liberty was 4-3 in the final month of the calendar year. Under Head Coach Carey Green, the Lady Flames have posted a 24-23 mark in December.

This season, Liberty has seven games scheduled during December, including five contests away from the Vines Center. Only four of the Lady Flames' first 13 games this season will be played in Lynchburg.

Rewriting the Record Book

Liberty set a Vines Center record for field goal percentage defense on Nov. 16 when it limited Columbia Union to 13.3 percent (8-60) shooting from the floor. The Lady Flames' 97 points represented the team's largest scoring output since the team defeated Cedarville, 103-61, on Dec. 13, 1997 and are the most points Liberty has scored under Carey Green's direction.

The More Things Change, The More They Stay The Same

With zero seniors graduating from last year's Liberty team and no freshmen joining this year's squad, Lady Flames Head Coach Carey Green has the rare luxury of suiting up the exact same 14 players for two-consecutive seasons. He also returns his entire coaching staff from the 2005-06 campaign.

Championship Streaks Continue

The Lady Flames' current streak of dominance in the Big South Conference puts them among the nation's longest conference championship runs. Liberty hoisted the Big South Championship trophy for the 10th-straight year a season ago, keeping alive the second-longest active string of conference tournament titles in the nation. Only Old Dominion, among NCAA Division I teams, currently owns a longer streak, having won 15-consecutive CAA conference crowns.

Liberty has also earned nine-straight Big South regular season titles. Only UC Santa Barbara, who has claimed 11-consecutive Big West regular season championships, owns a lengthier string of success.

Lady Flames Set to Battle Wide Range of Non-Conference Foes

This season, Liberty will battle teams from nine different Division I conferences during its non-conference slate. These include the ACC (Virginia and Virginia Tech), the America East (Binghamton), the Atlantic 10 (George Washington), the BIG EAST (Pittsburgh), the CAA (George Mason and James Madison), the MAAC (Marist), the MEAC (Norfolk State), the Patriot (American) and the Southland (Texas-Arlington). The Lady Flames could also square off with UNC Greensboro of the Southern Conference at the Dec. 29-30 Terrapin Classic.

Difficult Road Ahead

The Lady Flames are set to face one of the most ambitious non-conference schedules in program history this season. Liberty is slated to play three teams (George Washington, Marist and Virginia Tech) that qualified for the 2006 NCAA Tournament and could meet a fourth, defending national champion Maryland, at the Dec. 29-30 Terrapin Classic.

Three other foes on the Lady Flames' 2006-07 schedule (James Madison, Pittsburgh and Virginia) participated in the Women's NIT Tournament a season ago. Pittsburgh was a semifinalist in the event.

Eight of Liberty's nine non-conference games that will be played away from the Vines Center come against teams that posted winning records during the 2005-06 season.

Liberty Against Non-Conference Opponents

The Lady Flames have posted a 242-276 all-time record in non-conference games. Liberty's best non-conference season came in 1997-98 when the Lady Flames went 14-1 outside the Big South. The Lady Flames' only non-conference loss that season came to eventual national champion Tennessee in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The Lady Flames were 12-5 in non-conference tilts a season ago and are 5-1 outside the Big South this season.

Lady Flames Excel in the Classroom

Liberty is not only enjoying a string of success on the hardwood, but the Lady Flames have received national recognition for their work in the classroom. Liberty tied with Lehigh for 14th in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Top 25 Honor Roll this past season on the strength of its 3.338 team GPA.

This is the third time in program history that the Lady Flames have been included in the Top 25 Honor Roll. Liberty ranked 13th in 1999-2000, Carey Green's first season at Liberty. The Lady Flames were also 12th in 1998-99.

Liberty has been picked to win the Big South Conference title for the 11th-straight season, sophomore guard/forward Megan Frazee was tabbed as the Big South Preseason Player of the Year and junior guard Allyson Fasnacht was named to the Big South All-Conference Team for the second straight year. These distinctions were the result of a poll taken by the conference head coaches, sports information directors and selected media.

The Lady Flames, who return their entire 14-player roster from last season, received 21 of a possible 26 first-place votes and 202 total points to easily outdistance High Point. Liberty was 13-1 in conference play a season ago and captured the Big South Championship for the 10th-consecutive time.

High Point, which dealt Liberty its only regular season loss and was the runner-up of the conference tournament, took four first-place votes and racked up 178 total points, finishing second in the balloting.

Winthrop, the most improved team in the conference a season ago, got 136 points to rank third. Coastal Carolina was tabbed to finish fourth with 117 points. Radford picked up the last remaining first-place vote and was selected fifth with a total of 115 points.

UNC Asheville, the host of the 2007 Big South Championship, was picked sixth with 100 points. Birmingham-Southern and Charleston Southern shared seventh place with 44 points apiece.

Frazee, who was averaging 18.5 ppg and 9.8 rpg as a freshman before an ACL injury during game 14 ended her season, is the first Liberty player to be selected Big South Preseason Player of the Year since Katie Feenstra in 2004.

Fasnacht is coming off of a season that saw her be named to the Big South All-Conference first-team roster and take home Big South Championship MVP honors.

Unbelievable at UVa

Megan Frazee put on an incredible scoring exhibition in Liberty's Nov. 20 win at Virginia, tossing in 31 of her 37 markers after halftime. Her 31 points is believed to equal a school record for points in one half. Elena Kisseleva tallied 31 points in the second half of a 96-90 win over Akron on Dec. 7, 1996.

Frazee's 37 points represents the third-highest single-game scoring output in program history. Katie Feenstra holds the record with 40 points, a standard she established on Feb. 3, 2004 against Winthrop.

Triple the Trouble

The Nov. 11 season opener against Norfolk State marked the first time that all three Frazee triplets (Megan, Molly and Moriah) scored in double figures in the same contest since arriving at Liberty. Megan led the way with 19 points, Moriah added 14 and Molly matched her then-career high with 10 markers. The trio pulled off the same feat in a Nov. 14 game at George Mason, as Megan totaled 25 points, Moriah had 15 and Molly again scored 10.

Megan, Molly and Moriah were all included in the Liberty starting lineup on Nov. 29 at James Madison, marking the first time that all three triplets have started together at Liberty.

The Frazees are the only set of triplets currently playing Division I women's basketball.

Coming From Behind

The Lady Flames erased a 10-point halftime deficit to win at George Mason on Nov. 14, 61-56. That marked the first time since Jan. 4, 2005, that Liberty has won a game after trailing by 10 or more points at the intermission. The Lady Flames trailed Loyola (Md.), 38-26, after 20 minutes of play before rallying for an 80-69 road victory.

Sparkling Seniors

Four seniors (Jamie Feagin, Leslie Jones, Michelle Parker and Karolina Piotrkiewicz) are included on the Liberty roster this season. If the Lady Flames accumulate 25 or more wins this season, that quartet will graduate as the winningest class in program history. The Class of 2005, which included Katie Feenstra, Rima Margeviciute, Daina Staugaitiene, Kristal Tharp and Stephanie Walker, currently holds that title, finishing its four-year run with a 100-26 (.794) record.

This year's seniors have gone 81-21 (.794) through their first three-plus years at Liberty. The Lady Flames have recorded 25 or more wins in each of the last four seasons.

Best in the Big South

Through the games of Dec. 3, Liberty leads the Big South Conference in scoring defense (54.3 ppg), scoring margin (+20.7), free throw percentage (.731), field goal percentage (.459), field goal percentage defense (.308), total rebounds (46.3 rpg), defensive rebounds (32.2 rpg), rebounding margin (+12.2), assists (16.7 apg) and assist-to-turnover ratio (0.93).

Individually, Megan Frazee paces the conference in rebounding (10.0 rpg) and defensive rebounds (7.5 rpg). Michelle Parker ranks first in the Big South in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.78).

National Rankings

For the first time this season, Liberty received a single vote in last week's AP Top 25 Poll. Possible opponent Maryland is ranked first and the Lady Flames' foe on Sunday, George Washington, is No. 21. Opponents Pittsburgh and Virginia are also listed among the "Others Receiving Votes."

It's a Good Sign if ...

Liberty was perfect during the 2005-06 season when playing at home (15-0), when playing a team with a record of .500 or below (16-0), when holding a lead with five minutes remaining in the game (25-0), when attempting more free throws than its opponent (19-0), when its opponents commit more turnovers (8-0), when it comes up with at least as many steals as its opponent (11-0), when scoring 71 or more points (7-0), when playing on Tuesday (4-0) or Friday (3-0) and when wearing its white uniforms (17-0).

It's Not a Good Sign if ...

Liberty was winless during the 2005-06 season when trailing with five minutes remaining (0-6), when being outrebounded (0-4), when scoring 50 or fewer points (0-3) and when playing on Sunday (0-2).

Lack of Overtime

For the second-straight season, Liberty did not play a single overtime contest in 2005-06. The last time that the Lady Flames had to play more than 40 minutes came on Jan. 6, 2004, when Liberty defeated American, 76-72, on the road in double overtime. Since that game, the Lady Flames have played 89-straight non-overtime games.

The Lady Flames' most recent overtime loss came on Dec. 6, 2004 against #24 Boston College at the Brown Classic. BC took a 74-70 decision in that contest.

Liberty's last overtime contest at the Vines Center was a memorable one. The Lady Flames defeated Virginia, 77-69, in overtime on Nov. 26, 2002, to claim their first-ever win over the Cavaliers.

Controlling the Commonwealth

Liberty fared well against in-state opponents a season ago, going 6-1 against fellow Virginia institutions. The Lady Flames went 1-0 vs. Longwood, 1-0 vs. Norfolk State, 2-0 vs. Radford, 1-0 vs. Virginia Union and 1-0 vs. William & Mary. Liberty's lone loss against a Virginia school came at Virginia Tech (Dec. 10).

The Lady Flames are 3-1 against in-state opponents this season, owning victories over George Mason, Norfolk State and Virginia and dropping a game at James Madison. Longwood, Radford (twice), Virginia Union and Virginia Tech are scheduled to play Liberty later this season.

A Fast Start for Frazee

Liberty sophomore Megan Frazee is tied with classmate Alexandria Bream for the fewest career appearances among active Lady Flames (20). Yet, Frazee has scored more career points (376) than any of her teammates, an average of 18.8 ppg. Elena Kisseleva, Liberty's all-time leading scorer with 2,154 points, posted 18.1 ppg during her four years with the Lady Flames.

15th Year in the Furnace

The 2006-07 season is the 15th season that the Liberty University women's basketball team has called the Vines Center its full-time home. The Lady Flames' Jan. 22 Big South home opener against Winthrop will be Liberty's 200th contest at the facility. The "Furnace" has served as a favorable facility for the Lady Flames over the years. Liberty is 156-39 (.800) all-time at the Vines Center and has won 21-consecutive games at the facility.

Lynchburg, Va.

Sophomore Megan Frazee excelled in her return from a knee injury, leading all players with 19 points and 13 rebounds in Liberty's season opener and home opener, a 91-53 win over the Norfolk State Spartans. Consecutive three-pointers by the Spartans' Tiffany Jenkins highlighted a 13-1 run which gave the visitors a 14-7 lead with 14:20 showing on the first-half clock. Norfolk State's lead stood at 25-23 before Molly Frazee ignited a 20-0 Liberty run with a three-pointer. Much of the surge came with the Lady Flames' second unit on the floor. Liberty sophomore Rebecca Lightfoot notched five points during the run and the Lady Flames forced 15-consecutive missed shots by Norfolk State. Liberty took a 47-27 advantage into the locker room. Early in the second half, the Spartans trimmed the lead to 18 (55-37) on a Toia Johnson three-pointer at the 15:43 mark. The Lady Flames then put the game away with an 18-3 burst which included eight free throws. Moriah Frazee's layup at 8:10 of the second half made the score 73-40, Liberty. From that point on, the Lady Flames cruised to a 91-53 victory. Eleven of the Liberty players who saw action reached the scoring column, helping the Lady Flames score their most points since totaling 94 in a Dec. 4, 1999 game at Richmond. Liberty outrebounded the visitors, 62-37, and dished out 25 assists. Five Lady Flames, including all three Frazee triplets, reached double figures. Jenkins paced the Spartans with 15 markers.

Game 2
Fairfax, Va.

The Frazee triplets combined to score 50 of Liberty's 61 points, helping the Lady Flames overcome a 10-point halftime deficit and take a 61-56 victory at George Mason. The win was the Lady Flames' first in 12 tries against the Patriots. Liberty took advantage of four-straight George Mason turnovers to jump out to a 7-0 lead. The Patriots nailed three-straight three-pointers during an 11-0 run that gave the home team a 33-25 lead 3:25 before halftime. George Mason's C'Vette Henson then banked in a shot from long range just before the halftime buzzer, giving the Patriots a 39-29 advantage at the break. The home team took an 11-point lead, 43-32, early in the second half, before Liberty commenced its comeback. An 11-2 run, capped by a Michelle Parker jumper, lifted the Lady Flames to their first lead of the second half, 53-52, with 5:20 remaining in the contest. George Mason would not lead again, going the last 9:20 of the game without a field goal and tallying just four free throws during that period. The Patriots still had a chance to tie the game, as they were down by three points in the final 30 seconds before Megan Frazee rebounded a missed three-pointer and sealed the win with a pair of charity tosses. Megan Frazee recorded her second-straight double-double, posting game-high totals in both points (25) and rebounds (12). Moriah Frazee chipped in with 15 points and six boards.

Game 3
Lynchburg, Va.

Liberty jumped out to a 16-0 lead and never looked back, cruising to its third-consecutive win to start the year and its 21st-straight victory at the Vines Center, a 97-27 triumph over Columbia Union. Courtney Watkins tallied five points during the game-opening 16-0 run as the Lady Flames kept the Pioneers off the scoreboard for the first 6:15 of play. Megan Frazee's shot in the paint capped a 19-0 surge later in the opening half, giving Liberty a 45-6 advantage 2:20 before half-time. The home team's lead stood at 47-8 at intermission. Columbia Union's Lisa Brewer tossed in all of her team-high 10 points after the half, but Liberty was able to go on to claim a 97-27 win. The point total was the Lady Flames' highest single-game output during Head Coach Carey Green's tenure and was the team's most since a 103-61 win over Cedarville on Dec. 13, 1997. The 70-point margin of victory represented Liberty's most lopsided score since a 104-15 victory over Valley Forge on Jan. 14, 1995. Liberty limited Columbia Union to 13.3 percent (8-60) shooting from the field, establishing a Vines Center record for field goal percentage defense. Karolina Piotrkiewicz led all players in points (14) and rebounds (12). Megan Frazee added 13 points and eight boards in only 15 minutes of action. All 13 players who saw playing time for Liberty reached the scoring column.

Game 4
Charlottesville, Va.

Liberty sophomore Megan Frazee scored 31 of her career-high 37 points after half-time, enabling the Lady Flames to erase a nine-point second-half deficit and claim a 75-71 win at Virginia. The victory was Liberty's second-ever triumph against its in-state rival and was the Cavaliers' first-ever loss in the new John Paul Jones Arena. The home team got off to a fast start, taking a 14-1 lead at the 13:17 mark of the first half. Liberty chipped away at the Virginia advantage and took its first lead, 32-30, at 2:44, when Michelle Parker scored the third of three-consecutive transition baskets for the Lady Flames. The Cavaliers owned a 34-32 lead at the intermission. Liberty's bench helped the team remain within striking distance during the initial 20 minutes, tallying 23 of the Lady Flames' 32 points. Virginia used a 9-0 surge to take a 57-48 lead with 10:03 left in the game. Sharnee Zoll, who led the Cavaliers with 20 points, had the last two hoops of that run. Liberty responded with an 18-3 burst. Moriah Frazee's two free throws at 2:34 gave the Lady Flames a 66-60 lead, one they would not relinquish. A Monica Wright four-point play and a three-point play by Zoll allowed Virginia to cut the lead to one point (72-71), but the Lady Flames hit five-of-six free throws in the final minute to seal the win. Megan Frazee's point total was the third-highest single-game output in program history and she also grabbed a game-high 15 boards. Molly Frazee added a career-best 11 markers. Liberty improved to 4-0 for the second time in program history.
